How to Connect Your Android Device to the “KSU” WiFi Network



Android phone layouts may differ by model, but will be very similar

You may get a screen pop-up asking to create a credential storage password during these instructions if you have never created one. Create a password and remember it, as this is a password to view and change credentials stored on your phone

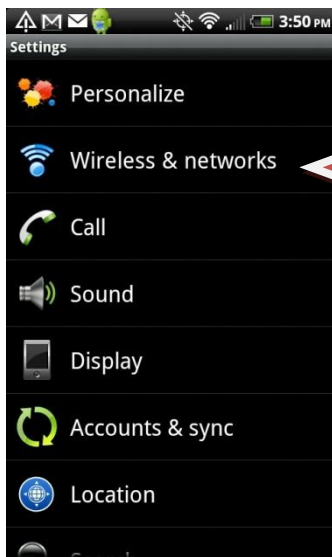
1. On the Home screen, click on your **MENU** icon or button. The screen below will appear at the bottom of your phone. Then select the **Settings** icon.

2. The screen below will appear. Select **WIRELESS & NETWORKS** from the list shown.

The following screen will appear.

3. Select **Wi-Fi** from the list shown on Figure 3.

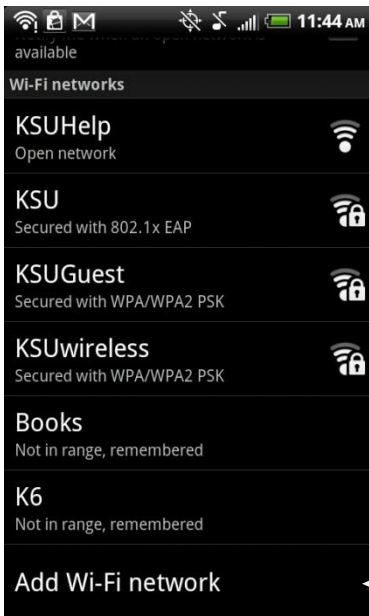
Note: If your Wi-Fi is disabled, this will enable it.

4. Now select **Wi-Fi settings** on the same screen.
5. The screen below should appear. Scroll to the bottom and select **add Wi-Fi network** shown on Figure 4.

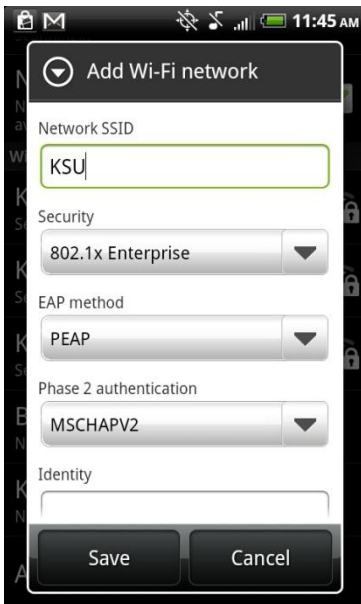


Select **Add Wi-Fi network**

- The screen below will appear. Use the instructions shown on Figure 5.

Leave any settings not shown blank or un-checked



Enter **KSU** for Network SSID



Select **802.1x Enterprise** for Security



Select **PEAP** for the EAP method



Select **MSCHAPv2** for authentication

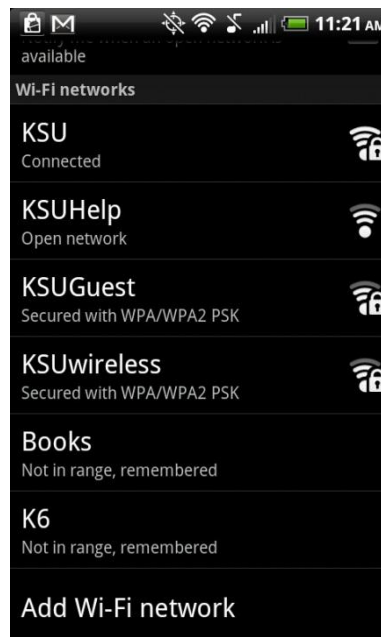
- Now that you have created and saved the “KSU” profile try to connect it from your Wi-Fi networks. You should see it trying to connect as shown below.
